 - Recommendations for the empty seat on the Planning and Zoning Board.

 - 325 Old Newnan Road, rezoning of 1 acre. Planning and zoning has made a recommendation and will present it at the Council Meeting.

 - Jackie Pate: The foundation has approached friends and offered up to \$300,000 in funds for the library over 10 years, they ask that the City of Whitesburg still provided the support they are currently providing. With the donations that have been given to the library, the library was able to give pay raises.
 - **Steven Mason**: If we keep everything at the current level, then we will apply for assistance from the state. We would like to add dedicated parking and additions to the library.
 - Sheri Wright: The library currently has 1,868 active patrons. In the last quarter we had 3,300 people come through the library. We are planning for the Summer Reading and will implement a free pantry. Last summer the library grew 155 pounds of vegetables that went to the residents in the City of Whitesburg. The library is offering computer classes, and they are filling up.
 - Jackie Pate: The Thursday before Easter the Methodist Church will host a last supper at the Whitesburg Recreation Center. Tickets are needed to attend this event.
